

## Hawaiian Paradise Park Paths Committee Minutes- 11/19/13

The committee meeting was started at 6:00 PM in the HPPOA Library

Committee members present: Larry Brennan, Dean Silber, and Mary Cashman.

- Review of October's Minutes: Minutes for the 10/15/13 meeting were approved as read.
- Report on PATHS Hawaii Facilities Meeting 11/6/13: Dean reported on PATHS Hawaii recent Facilities Committee Meeting. Dean presented at the meeting the following items: John Seastroms "Sharrows" connection with Ron Thiel of DOT: only likely use will be Alii Dr, speeds on HPP roads too high for sharrows, Kauai is ahead on bike issues, DOT not have stencil yet, possible use of sharrows discussed during Oct HPP Paths committee.  
  
Hui Trail Development: from the county R&D discovery mtg, starting small. Day one of Hui trail clearing
- Laura led discussion about Complete Streets, Dan Burden coming in December, possibilities of people from DOHealth and DOPublic Works going through three HPP sites: Hui Trail, county parcels on the coast, 20 acre site on 26th Ave
- Dean reported that Tina described possible options for the bike education HPP General Mtg: can be two groups (kids under 17, and adults over 17), approximate time 1.5 -2.5 hrs, includes some classroom time, drills on riding skills, and a ride through HPP. Tina needs to know approx. number of participants in early Feb. (more discussion of this followed later in meeting, see below).
- Report on PATHS Hawaii General Meeting 11/5/13: Dean reported that PATHS Hawaii Board President thanked Laura as past Ex. Dir. and introduced Tina Clothier as current Ex. Dir. PATH Hawaii is developing a phone app for Hawaii Island trails and paths. Dean brought copy of PATH Hawaii Island Bike Guide and Trail Map (hard copy) to HPP Paths meeting for review.
- Discussion of PATHS Hawaii Bike Safety Event for HPP February Membership Meeting We discussed having the event prior to the Membership meeting (ie. 12:30pm-2:30 pm, member mtg at 3pm). Dean will get a sample flyer from PATHS HAWAII for us to use in advertising this event. We will make further plans at next HPPOA PATHS meeting. Tasks for the Dec meeting include: 1) Identify participants for advertisement (ie. Churchs, schools), 2) Identify a route for the ride, 3) Develop the flyer
- Report on HPP Hui Trail Work: Dean reported that 2<sup>nd</sup> work day was 11/8/13. Vern Presnall, John Seastrom, and Dean Silber continued from 1<sup>st</sup> day progress. The second day's work extended the 17th Street side of the Hui Trail to within approximately 50 yards (using line of sight from the #6 power pole on 17th Avenue) of the north eastern HPPOA Community Center property line. The trail then runs roughly parallel to the property line to within approximately 75 yards of 16th Avenue. Work ended around 11:30am at a large mango tree. Dean marked the trail with pink flags, photo-documented, and is keeping detailed record of trail progress.
