## Greetings!

The last publication of the Conch came out in February 2021. Many things have transpired since then that have prohibited getting information out via this media - Covid being the largest reason. The Conch will be posted on the [HPPOA.net](https://www.hpboa.net) website every four months as well as a link to it posted on FaceBook and other social media.

The website has been brought up to date with most, if not all, pertinent information. It is now being added to in a more timely manner which should make it much easier to keep up with current events.

Technology has come a long way since we began HPPOA and we're doing our best to bring HPPOA up to what used to be 'the future'. We're asking as many as possible to opt-in to receiving all communications via electronic methods, email, social media, website and using online forms. If you or your neighbor need a hard copy of The Conch just stop by the office and the very nice office staff will print out a copy for you.

## Mail Parks Update

Here is where we are to date. The permits have finally been issued on 16th and Makuu site for the final grading and asphalt to be completed. We were required to have an archeological walk through completed for the 16th & Makuu and the 14th & Kaloli sites for permits to be issued. That was completed and now we will be finishing the site work at both locations.

This Mailbox project is a \$3 million dollar project. We are very fortunate to be receiving \$2 million in mailboxes and \$500k in installation expenses from USPS. This is very rare and we are grateful that we were able to be the recipient of these boxes. All we were asked to do was provide the sites and prepare them to the required specs so we are ADA compliant and off the main roads. They are requesting the mailboxes be covered but that will be done at a later date.

To date the Mail Parks project has had \$492,447.01 in site preparation costs. We will have expense ahead for the remainder of the site work at \$91,328.76 and lights at \$50,100.

Once the boxes are installed at 4th & Kaloli, they will begin to install at the 6th & Makuu site. It is the hope that the site work for 14th & Kaloli and 16th & Makuu will be completed by then so that installation can begin immediately at those sites.

Once we get the go ahead from USPS, we will begin key distribution from the office. We will put up banners on the main roads to let everyone know and post it on the website. We will keep you posted on what is required to pickup keys.

Once all 4 sites have mail service available, notification to all current boxes on the main roads will be given as to when service will be discontinued and the box removal will begin. For full reports please see the [President's Corner](#) and the [Mail Parks Reports](#) on our [website](#).
